A cracker was thrown outside of pen 5 metres from seal the seal dove in the same direction, After the cracker went off the seal surfaced. The seal was showing lots of blood and blowing a lot of bubbles before sinking and not sighted again. Juvenile Fur Seal estimated between 50 to 70kg
